Firstly, thanks to all the participants of the Tracking Derby competition. With the aid of a GSP strapped to the hand 21 jumpers tried to fly the greatest horizontal distance in freefall. Speeds reached upto 240 km/h (ground speed) over the 35 second course. Over four days the jumpers saw their performance improve as tracking positions became more refine.
